December 5 continued Saturday Forward  
 and brought up bag Manitoba flour on due bill from Armstrongs. In P.M. I went down for chop took Bella and May down with me. I paid for 3 slopings <sup>160</sup>  
 May got at Steels Bowling <sup>60</sup> & featherbone <sup>8</sup> she also got groceries at Armstrongs <sup>95</sup> on c/c Bella stayed down. I drove down in cutter at night changed leggings at Fitzpatrick's rebate <sup>35</sup>  
 got at Whitehead's brass <sup>22</sup> at Webster's pipe <sup>7</sup>  
 paid Hamilton for tile got in June <sup>710</sup>. Got from Argo for butter 10 lbs @ 18 <sup>180</sup>

8 Sunday.  
 Cloudy a little stormy not very frosty. Mr Mc Vicar preached in A.M. from Jonah 3:1. Second chances and Mr Scott of Metz in St Andrews at night to United congregation from <sup>the good to draw near to God</sup>. We all drove down in cutter at night. Collection St Andrews <sup>15</sup>

7 Monday  
 Cloudy not very frosty. Snowing some. Willie at Skeoch's thrashing. I took our ram over to D. Clarke's in slough then hauled enough stones to fill hole in Pond bottom of No 7 that I dug in fall then brought up load wood for thrashing. Willie took 12 bags chop down in P.M. got 2 lamp glasses at Armstrongs. <sup>20</sup>

8 Tuesday  
 Cloudy day snowing heavy most day. Chilly.
