Cloudy. raining some in A.M. cleared off late P.M. warm. Willie took 20 $\frac{1}{4}$  doz eggs to cold storage @ 16 cts \$3.24 brought a load manure from Frank's to pile. Mr Kinear in. to see cattle offered at \$5.00 per cut for 2 weeks hence. P.M. Willie plowed some more in No 7 stump field. and I put down some more cement floor in pig pen. I cleaned and out A.M. Mr Bass over at night for milk 5 cts. The last 2 of the hand fed pigs died to-day. Mary and Willie drove down in evening Lucy in buggy
