Fine sunny day warm. Willie scuffled turnips in A.M. with Dick and in P.M. disk harrowed stump field No 7 & pulled flax all day. I drove down town at night got at Russells tape and shoe blacking 11cts at Menmies carpet tacks 5cts at Adam Armstrongs can salmon 18cts postcards 5

Sunday

Fine day sunny. Mr Jos Gennie preached in A.M. from Numbers 33:9. and in evening from Genesis 42:36. Mrs J. Chees and Russell down at auction Ch. Coll 50cts

28

Monday

Cloudy most day a few drops rain in A.M. We finished harvest to-day 4 loads Joenette oats from No 6 W. We scuffed some rape with Jess in morning to train her in. Jos Mitchell here to-day pulling flax. Father up in P.M. helping off with load. Mary bought from pedlar needles and pins 10cts

29

Tuesday

Warm day sunny and cloudy thunder lightning tonight. Willie spread board enclosure from Steels on No 5 with load wood home got at Mills roast wheat etc at Armstrongs rope tarantula and groceries 45. In P.M. he harrowed twice stump field. John Mitchell pulling flax. Nellie and baby Jennie and Norman Auntie and Mrs J. Chees & Russell all up for tea. Mr Gance drove Mrs Knox up in P.M. I day out about ram box and cut top of preparatory to driving it down it has been heated with put. This is my birthday also Mrs J. Chees.
