PM Sam Mc Kee + Sam Sess over helped us saw wood in bush circular saw. We got engine stuck in dry black mucka crossing No 3 broke 3 horse doubletree we put on an extra horse got 4 horse doubletrees and hauled it down to No 6 bush near G.S. Willie and Sam^{Mc Kee} took engine over to Sam's place after tea. Mrs Sess also over for tea. Three boys Bain Russell and Langert up for pigeons at night only got one so gave it to me I killed it. Marshall Day here in auto PM fixing his ditcher first time he has been back since last fall

Friday

Cloudy AM drizzling a little cleared off by P.M. got cooler I went over in morning with Sam Mc Kee who took circular saw over We sawed wood at his place till about noon when an iron broke Willie got it mended at Hodge 25c. Willie took cream down to Russell's station got plow wheel mended at Hodge 75c. PM Willie got iron put right at Hodge as he put it on wrong AM then sawed at Mc Kee's until I came around with 10 bags chop which Willie

167 took to mill and I stayed at Mc Kee's wet/dry Willie paid chop 67c took hammers to Mc Kee's and returned plow axle to Chapman I got Quercy right. He brought from Malcolm 4.24" culvert tiles as the others we think too small. Willie brought molton from station from Baldmoy in evening Ray Black in tonight see about corn for corn feast at Main River. Ray
