Friday 25. Marjorie went to Elifton had 10 1/2 lb butter
the sold 6 1/2 to Taylor for 24^{cts} & Jane 4 1/2 @ 24. got 50^{cts} sugar
tea 26^{cts}. coconut 15^{cts}. peppers 7. basil 5. celery 5. onion 5
rope 35^{cts}. 2 baskets of Plums 50^{cts} bread 12. brought
up the pot Jennie gave her, she got 20^{cts} for them
butter at Eden. Nellie & Estie Darkers back day 17
Paul at the Bredies pulling beans made 50^{cts} &
got his supper at home. Will & Arthur drawing
manure. I guarded the cows after I worked
the butter in rolls for town. after I turned the
cows out I washed dishes for an hour & half, then
caught a chicken & cooked it for our supper
then churned. just washed the churn looked
out & saw all the cables out. Had a big time getting
them out Marjorie just got home & had to help
Sat 26 Marjorie to Beebe. took a crock with 6^{cts}
got 22 at Taylors. got 11^{cts} worth of Sages, 1^{cts} shell
a loaf of bread & 24^{cts} in cash she brought home a few
tomatoes & a mess of corn. Paul guarded the cows & Nellie

drawed a barrel of water I got him his down at 9
11 o'clock then he went after the wagon to draw manure
Haynes 2 hours & a half. George & Allen drawed the oats
Will & Arthur drawing manure. I swept & cleaned
both rooms. worked the butter. put clean paper on both
cupboards. had a lot of work getting the hen caught
& shut up. cool wind north east but sun gentle
Sun 27. cold nights nowadays just like frost.
& today the wind is cold from the north east
Marjorie went to church. came home highly incensed
with the singing. Sharpe & the other house brought home
honey Hattley there & Mary Marshall & her husband Lou.
Mon 28 I churned. Marjorie washed out quite a
lot of her own clothes & ironed them for her while
thirt. Paul drawing manure. Will & Arthur drawing
manure. I carried up 4 fars of Plums
Tue 29. I swept the school house. yesterday morning
I did not get a chance Friday or Sat & might
swept again. Nellie & Miss Thompson Hahn went
after school. Nell called her with Fannie they
did not start until nearly dark on Sat it was
dark Will & Arthur stretching at Peckingers
they were to come here & stretch out oats but
some new arrangement they had put off
until Sat. likely have a big rain before that
they took Topsy down on the farm on after then
took 3 doz 13 eggs, got 11^{cts} 1/2 tea plum
5^{cts} fly paper 25^{cts} bottle Hercul paint destroyed & swept
& dusted tonight Paul drawing manure
