Fine sunny warm day. Willie scuffed or rather drilled up potatoes and I finished hoeing turnips second time. We got in fall wheat 4 1/2 loads. Father and mother up in P.M. the former helped us with loads in snow. Auntie, Jennie and Norman and Besse up in evening got from auntie for butter 20cts  
 Father and mother chummed in evening for us. meat 25cts

Thursday

Very warm day sunny and cloudy thunder in P.M. dark clouds passing around us. Willie cut oats in No 6 E to-day. I hoed a row each of mangels and carrots then stalked up Father up in P.M. earthed and weeded row celery.

Friday

Fine warm cloudy day some sunshine Willie cut all day oats in No 7 W. I finished stocking No 6 E and in P.M. pro Damsen and I stocked in No 7 W.

Saturday

Fine day looked like rain at times. We finished cutting oats in No 7 W, and stalked rest of them Father up in P.M. I drove him down at night. I got at Merris one of fly mixture 1 1/2 pints fish oil 4 1/2 lbs resin 30cts at Armstrongs one of 4 lbs soap 60cts got at Allans parcel from Eaton express 35cts goods amounted to 643  
 paid for Damsen 60cts Omitted in Eaton order 19cts
