23 fine showers to day had some in the garden

24 I went to granogue with R Fields to assist P  
Fleasip in a trial for Setting Liquor on Sunday  
the case was adjourned till next Tuesday

25 put Parcs green on the potatoes in the garden put on  
to to has fine rows to do yet to cut the Rye at  
the Road or rather Wallace for to went to a bee drawing  
stones for the English church

27 Ad & Wallace cut our Rye at the old house  
all but a piece fast said very windy

28 Ad & Wallace drew in 2 loads of the Rye mixed  
it with old chaff & straw this forenoon then  
they went home to draw in there very warm

29 Ad & Wallace drew in there Rye at the Road <sup>day</sup>

30 I attended an Agricultural meeting at Mr Dens  
Revd Mr Brown preached this morning Mr Nicholson  
at night very warm day
