Vernon boiled in the bush this morning and Walter this p.m. There were heavy thunder storms and rain this afternoon and we lit the lamp at 4³⁰ as it was almost as dark as night. The rain came down ^{in torrents} almost like a cloudburst. Heavy damage done in different parts of U. S. A. and Canada by floods and tornadoes.
