

July 5 I finished mowing <sup>meadow</sup> near Hoover's until

6 I & W took horse rake to ~~the~~ ~~shop~~ M Barkholder  
to get new tooth in this morning began to rake  
up hay about half past 10 O'clock began to  
rain about 2 P.M. stopped our operations  
heavy shower tonight I took Matty Shunk  
to Cobey & brought shovel plow from B. N.  
7 We all except Adeline went to Grandpa Hoover's  
on a visit to see the railway & to see the cars  
run it was a great sight for the little ones  
boys put shovel plow through corn & raked  
& locked some dry W. fine clear pretty wind  
8 Drew in all hay out of field near Hoover's loads  
I went to Whitewater this evening to get some Brandy  
for my mother she has Bowel Complaint W. fine  
Sunday 9 at home all day C. B. & B. D. were here  
P.M. W. very warm. Cooler this evening mother  
10 I went to Markham A.M. cut <sup>some</sup> little meadow  
except a strip for timothy seed W. began  
crossing old fallow W. fine clear. <sup>like</sup> rain  
11 I went to Whitewater for some <sup>bag</sup> & drove a  
load of peastraw for M. Dyke A.M. helped Nancy  
pick black raspberries P.M. Dave raked over  
meadow near Hoover's & raked little meadow  
W. a little rain this morning. Clear warm today  
12 Drew in load rapine, out of field near Hoover's  
& 4 loads out of little meadow which finishes haying  
except little orchard

12 W. mowed <sup>July</sup> that this morning & this evening. I &  
little boys to grist & chop to mill this evening  
13 W. plowed & I chored A.M. all road turnip. <sup>W. fine</sup> clear  
I brought home grist after supper W. very warm  
14 hoad turnips. W. went to Jacob Reesor's barn  
mowing P.M. I & Dave took in load of hay out  
of little orchard & hoad turnip. W. very warm  
15 I & Nancy went Markham A.M. boy hoad  
turnips & plowed potatoes P.M. I & W brought  
home load of edgings & had a swim after  
supper W. very warm looks like rain  
Sunday 16 Went to Meeting at Cedar Grove Newark  
by B. C. Semmon on St. Luke 12 C 15 to 45 W  
by R. H. Barker went to B. D.'s after service my  
mother went to B. N. W. fine. Cooler  
17 Both plowed in old fallow Dave thinned turnips W.  
18 Both plowed A.M. W. finished <sup>in</sup> a few hours <sup>cool</sup> P.M.  
then we helped Dave hoe turnip. got pretty near  
done. W. a slight shower at noon very high <sup>wind</sup>  
19 I went to B. D. W. got Jess shod in Whitewater  
& then helped Dave finish turnips. A.M. I & W.  
helped B. N. bind wheat P.M. B. D. cut with  
his reaper W. fine. Clear. Cool  
20 Cut roads round Wheat. I was at B. C.'s awhile  
P.M. helping A. M. freight put together his new  
selfraking Buckeye reaper P.M. I & Nancy took  
yarn to A. Carnagie's after supper W. fine. <sup>cool</sup>  
21 Helped B. C. cut his old land wheat W. cool clear  
22 Cut our treawell wheat & a little Soules good crop  
W. Cool. I drove all day with vest & smock on
