in Summers's store Bought Summers 1/4 Tea
Bar of Soap 3 Bunches of Matches Got a Taste of cheese
one of the Dunlops Purua Fed with the small
Pole Kerosene oil Kenneth McDonald a
Bee Ploughing to day got a Piece of the Benison from
Hamilton cow head Henry came to night and
Murdoch McDonald fishing West Wind Brought
2 Bags of Potatoes to me put in the 2 calves to salt
for the Frost 26th Henry and Murdoch crossed River
to Murdoch's I seen Henry sailing back going
to Lancaster 27th found a Raft in the Bee Head
28th a Propeller Tow Boat ^{regains from plough} went up the River
past Mr ^{sewing} to night As its falling hard enough
to freeze ^{from} ^{almost} ^{by} ^{the} ^{ground}
hopping stove Wood 29th Beh emuan went
down early without calling into Lancaster
Dr Humeet as far as I could see the
St James called into Lancaster going
and coming I think its Jimmy Grants scow
that crossed and returned without nothing in it
wind kind of high 30th St Andrews Day
the Festival of the Scotch Firing in the Morning
and evening set Part of the Back clark a fire
but it will not Burn set 30th Brush
heaps a Fire which makes a bright
light. Bunt them clear the Steamer
Victoria went up this evening and
have them some good volleys but they
did not return it with a Blast of the Whistle
As there was no true Scotchmen aboard
of her I did not expect it a fine day
Cold and Pleasant no snow on the ground
lots of snow on the mountains Wild geese very
scarce Lights in the Lighthouses to night
