- July 17 Saturday. doing chores. hoeing turnips drawing in 3 loads hay. paring/greening potatoes. Carrie kicked about cooling milk & had a few words. Father & Mother drove over to Langford to see Albert Ramsay. they drove F.C. Brantwaite's horse.
- July 18 Sunday. doing chores. went to church morning & evening & at home the rest of day.
- July 19 Monday. doing chores. sprayed potatoes thinning turnips finished same. to day. F.W.M. cut piece of grass. A.E.V. set up buggy for minister. I payed Carrie her half of milk check \$10.47
- July 20 Tuesday. doing chores. cultivating mangles drawn in 4 loads hay this afternoon. F.W.M. finished cutting grass. & raking. Mother went to jeans to night. I had headache this afternoon.
- July 21 Wednesday. doing chores. went down street & seen about supplies for picnic booth. drew post along far fence. setting post this P.M. Mother away to jeans.
