19 Boys cut the most of the fall wheat Herman was here to dinner he went to

Spinks for Bran I went with him Daniels came this evening for Russell

Daniel Reasons came for Martin N. quite a bit cooler

20 Boys finished cutting fall wheat at 11 they cut sweat in wheat field P.M.

It was very warm again

Monday 21 girls & I got ready to go to meeting at Altona then it began to thunder in

there was a fine shower of rain then they waited awhile & went to Joseph Burkholts

to dinner & to Maria Burkholts to supper

July 1901

I & Mary & Susanna went to Bay's Store to dinner N. County A.M. pretty warm P.M.

The shower this morning just laid the dust 22 A fixed Binder Canvas I & Henry cut

sweat around young Swamp A.M. they cut Barley East of Creek & east of old

Orchard P.M. & brought in a load of the sweat hay that they cut on Saturday

N. pretty warm cooler after sunset I took 5 bags grit to Por. Dir. this

morning I & Mary went to Cedar Grove this evening & brought home

23 Henry got Mark Perry & Minnie there on Fox feet A finished fixing Mangles

A.M. then they brought in the last of the sweat hay & 4 loads barley south

of house N. very warm about 9 o'clock I went to see Bishop to come & sheet

up the Silo 24 A & Henry pitched some dung to

get room to build a straw stack & brought in 2 loads barley A.M.

A laid floor in new mow at Floris & Henry helped Floris dress in

Barley & Wheat P.M. N. very warm nearly 90 I took Susanna to P.D.

this morning & brought her home this evening
