

May 30th / 1873

Tue 30. Fine this morning, but it commenced raining about nine or ten o'clock but did not amount to much. Beautiful the rest of the day. Miss Hapgood has in her possession a curious freak of nature in the form of a butterfly. We intend to analyse it tomorrow.

Wed. 31. Fine today partly cloudy.

June 1st / 1873.

Thurs. 1. Very fine today, quite warm. The leaves on the trees in general are only just now about their full size.

The grain is mostly sown but many of the farmers are not yet through.

June 2nd / 1873.

Fri 2. Fine in the morning, but a light dash of rain visited us about the noon, very warm. Very hot all day, and having the appearance of rain, went to Kingston at night with Billy Clarke and arrived home in time to miss the light thunder shower about 11⁰⁰ PM.

Sat 3. Dull and warm in the morning clearing off again the rest of the day. no service on Sabbath school today on the account of the death of Mrs. A. Brown who died Friday June 2nd. Mrs. Lawrence attended the funeral.

Sun 4. Very fine today, cool and pleasant. Lovely summer weather.
