Mr James Cameron Island June 18th
This Decided Waterloo got 2 Eggs Boxes on the Water
Went to Alexis Inrupees and Ma-Houlas Island seen
Paul front on Alexis Island treated me got
some fat Pine found a Hat in the Water
and a Bunch of Letters on Alexis Island
Fishing to night got some 38 and Pike 18th Clearing the
chips from the Door 20th Last Day of Spring Rose Sunday
Allen the Barge and Jara Gil came to 1 stop
21st 4th Day of Summer the Barge ground
on the little channel north side of the Island on the stones
got the Loan of my canoe to put out their anchor a Raft of
3 or 4 sticks went down Before the Door it was
sticks that got lost from the Raft and they
Left them up at Black Horse Island Watering
the garden and some of the Potatoes made a Fish-Bone
a good many growing on the Water 22nd
Our Davis Birth Day I went with my Ashes
to James Gvents Bought of W. Pond & Bros in the new
Store 3 lb Tea 1 plug Tob 2 Chimney for Lamps Castor oil
Bar of Soap Hoe Matches Working at the Roads
Heard Old Alex. Kenneth or old No. 100 Departed
Yesterday got Potatoes from J. Hamilton took
Dinner there in the Ashery with Lewis Blondeau
Saw old D. McFeggor John Painting the Lighthouse
Some Thunder Rain Passed to the South side
Hoeing Potatoes gave a Loaf of Bread to the Barge
23rd Drawing Wood and took up 3 or 4 Barrels of water
for the Garden Windy 24th John the Baptiste
Went to Christie's Island for Pine Fishing to night
25th Hoeing the Potatoes Went down on the shoal
at the Surge Island got 5 38 is seen a Thuge
Gordon got 3 38 on our shoal Foot of the Island
Near the Horse-shoe seen a Large Lump Fan Day
Battle of Baynesburn Weeding the Garden 26th Old
John Rankin the Blacksmith here came across with
Dante Dougall and stop here all night went
out Fishing with Gordon and I got sturgeon Eel Succour
them to Rankin Robert Baker came went down in
him on my sturgeon shoal
and at Summers town

Gordon Went to Rosells for my sack and Gaff got
them got some Tobacco would not take no pay
Brought the children some sugar Hobart
Water Baker was in sail for going to
Stab John Carey expecting the new Boat up
Henry and George on the corinthian Indians
set Fire on the Pit Point Last night some Strawberries
Ripe down on the shoal Looking for 38s got
none got 38s of Fish at Pit Pit some drops
of Kam put out the Fish-Bone Yesterday East
Wind and West some Wind and calm on foggy
Mr Rankin came he being across with Dan McBrigall
Fishing with Rankin Gordon and I got 1 sturgeon Robert
Baker Frank Mayville Alex Durushie came I went with
them got 1 good sturgeon Sunday 27th Rankin went
to I Hopkins gave him all the fish we caught
28th Charlie Parsha and James Farmer here
for the Black Bull told them they could have
them 12 Chickens to Day Planted Cucumbers put salt on them
see if it would kill the fruits 29th Put out the Bag
store in the cook house and put the cooking stove out
went to the Kit Kist Island East Wind got 3 Pickers
2 chub 1 Perch took a Load of Wood found 4 boots
spikes in a stick Hoeing some commenced to Rain
Rained very heavy to night which is much wanted
beer Flies Bad Caterpillars plenty eating all the
leaves of the Trees ticks some St Peter's Day 30th
John and Charlie Hopkins here gave him 5 Pine Boards
took home his Plough cut a hickory for ax handles
Hoeing Potatoes cleaning the Boat the Wind Raised
high Filled the straw-tick Reeking Elm Bark 1st
July Dominion Day Very Windy a Pic Nick
Hamilton Island with the Victoria 2nd Went to
Hamiltons John Ploughing for Buckwheat Bordrian
planting a Place from John Bought of Miss Beyond Ball
head 2 Window Glass plug Tobacco Soda Took a letter
from John
