 1st of March St David's Day The Festival of
 Welsh Gaffy came in kind of like a Lion
 Windy West snow Flurries not very well
 got a Lead-Pencil 2nd of Wind Windy Fried
 iron-wood for colts cutting stove wood
 Water very Low have to go out in the channel
 to get Water froze to the Bottom all
 Bad with colds coughing and Barfing
 3rd a very Fine Day I went to Leurs Sisors
 seen a new corner Barnhart wife and children
 Barnhart there to Day at stove wood Drew the
 Marsh Hay from the Marsh and the Little
 4th Fine & Wind Leander crossed with the colts
 in the cutter to Hamletts the first time the
 colt crossed the ice Clearland on to Day
