Herbert Scott, left tonight, I paid him \$20⁰⁰ for the month and also paid Charlie, Seven dollars making in all \$20⁰⁰ that I have pd C. so far

24th Showery I went for meat in morning and Jno Henderson has agreed to buy. One Dark King 2nd Ear tag no 50 for \$15⁰⁰ and he is to pay for him next spring when he sells his fat cattle but if it is not convenient then he is to have longer time he takes him away about Nov 1st and he stays here until then at our risk, C Harrowed wheat stubble. I trimmed sheep and struck out lands in no 11. I sent \$1⁷⁵ to be left for Herbert Scott at Seroggs Grocery, and paid Mrs Barber \$3⁰⁰ for Freeman helping us sow wheat
