## Diagnosis of Perforating Ulcer.

When perforation of a duodenal ulcer has occurred, difficulty in diagnosis may arise owing to—(a) the pain being referred to the appendix region; (b) early and marked abatement of the severity of symptoms in cases where leakage from the perforation is limited by early adhesion taking place, or by edematous swelling of the intestinal wall in cases of very minute perforation.—J.
