24 David worked for Tom mowed & drew in one load

rain this afternoon

25 finished mowing front of Elizes the boys drew in 2 loads with of hay

26 went to John Youngs got 5 1/2 bushels of wheat & saw Chous Reaper cut fall wheat on the farm of Better Daves there was to have been 4 Reapers there but there was only Chous & Cogsets. Cogset & Chou could not agree about the Judges & Cogset would not reap & left the field some rain

27 went to Gyr with 9 1/2 bushel of wheat got 150 lb of corn meal 7.6 per hundred lb drew in at the last of the hay front of Elizes

28 mowed below the Bull well & drew in 2 loads from it fine say

30 very dull this morning Bob David Robert Armstrong & me went to the March on Sherwoods place
