Cloudy most day rained at times very once in a M. Mr Smellie up all day we got kitchen moved out on skids and some more made ready to move up garden.

Fine day sunny cool windy especially in PM. Mr Smellie and son Russell up till 2 PM we finished moving kitchen to the ground on rollers ready to move to yard. Paid them in full \$17.0. We rigged up bunks I got at Harps sale and cut some of the barley in No 1 E. I went downtown at night with jacks.
