Bismarck and Gordon Bosell here from and St  
the Head of the Island Fine Day some Windy  
18<sup>th</sup> The Ever memorable Battle of Waterloo  
Wedding the Potatoes Fine Went down to Ross Island  
fox ash oak stick sunk had hard work taking  
it up the Ella Kops went down in his first Trip  
19<sup>th</sup> Wedding Potatoes Warm got 2 Sturgeon from

The Fishermen Stanley and I went to Fish pond  
20<sup>th</sup> First Day of Summer Thunder and Lightning heavy  
Rain this morning turned very warm Wedding Potatoes  
put out 85 Tobacco Plants dug some in the Tobacco  
2 Barques stopt at the Light house going down I think  
they are loaded with coal 21<sup>st</sup> at Potatoes Fine

22<sup>nd</sup> Our Day Birth Day Bismarck here with a  
Big he Bought of Charlie Craig 5 weeks old pair  
2 Dollars some Ram 23<sup>rd</sup> Noon Charante came  
Leander crossed with Philip High Lem came  
from Dundee on the Steamer Grenada

24<sup>th</sup> St John the Baptiste Day Mr Gene came  
had a pig for me to weef's old he went to Com  
Laws the Proves here Mid-Summer Day Rained  
East Wind 25<sup>th</sup> Gene went off West Wind Fine

26<sup>th</sup> Muddle Calved at the Potatoes Leander the ship  
came with about 200 Tobacco plants digging  
the Tobacco Place 27<sup>th</sup> Went to Hamlet  
got Tomato Plants Fine Transplanted Tobacco

28<sup>th</sup> Hoeng Rotatoes Satted the Cattle Heard that  
Jeha Summers and her family came to Summers  
yesterday 28<sup>th</sup> East Wind Rained Made 10 Hours of Potatoes and

136 Hubs Mould Calved put out 60 Tobacco Plants  
at Door Apple Tree 82 of Lewis plants in Tobacco place  
29<sup>th</sup> St Peter & St Pauls Day Leander the Indian  
arriving a Bull Hoeng Potatoes and 2 Garveys

5 of them on of Mr Dougalls 82 of 47 of here  
Girls here

the House Mrs Charlotte here Fine Day

2<sup>nd</sup> Oscar and I working at Framing the House warm  
Fine 3<sup>rd</sup> Working at the Building My ocean sister  
came after him got the Rafters on gave him an old  
sine Fine Began to put Paris Green on the Potatoes

pound of nails from Phillips 4<sup>th</sup> of July the  
American Independence Fine Hoeng some Muddy  
Reggy spitting Boards on the Roof have a stick

to Fisherman to make an Ore Hoeng Stone  
5<sup>th</sup> Our Solars Birth Day 1803 Hoeng putting  
Paris Green on the Slugs cut a Road to the Board Back of  
the Room yesterday and put that Ray in to Day The

Bohemian changed in time she comes from a com  
at Dundee so she will try to get in a week before  
the Garnet 6<sup>th</sup> Hoeng Potatoes and Corn finished their  
Hoeng Beans 7<sup>th</sup> Leander crossed for Fisherman got 3 lbs

of Nails 25<sup>th</sup> cut a Road to the River and moved the staff  
Pasture Kaydol ph came through the night or near  
Morning 8<sup>th</sup> Gordon and David ph here Fine 9<sup>th</sup>  
Leander and St. Dundee sold to a 140 a barrel

1 Butter 20 a lb Bought of 2 1/2 lbs Tea 3 1/4. Ven 2-50 Tea 2 55  
Matches 20 Wash Basins 200 1/2 p 10 Mustard, Cash 1-35. 60 Dollars  
Bought of John 1/20 Book 75 Nails 3 2 Tomats 40
