Sun. 6. Cooler today having had a light
thunder shower last night
about 7 o'clock, it also
drizzled at intervals most
of the day but amounted to
very little met Mr John Bremer
at York. while there

Mon. 7. Looly and cool this forenoon
drove to J. S. Brown for
dinner to-day and took
the train from there for Hampton
and arrived home to night

Tue. 8. Very hot today. Jas. Lane & Joe
Redmond here at the factory, we
all engaged in a little shooting
match, and after ^{words} got funny
and ended up mad, over his
own fun, took a short walk down
to J. A. Harding for a while this
evening, enjoyed myself very
much and returned home

Aug 9th 1873.

Wed. 9. Another hot day, sky almost
cloudless, Lane here this
afternoon assisting with
the Booth belonging to the factory,
the evening lovely and cool
Extremely hot today thermometer
registered 96° in the shade

Thu. 10. The night was almost into
erable the hottest of the season
Another intensely hot day

Fri. 11. The hottest of the season
the sky cloudless from morn-
ing till night, has been so most
of the week the grass is all
burnt up, causing the cows
to dry up, so that I am get-
ting but very little milk now,
it clouded a little in the west
to night the sun setting behind
me with prospects for rain soon
at Mr Harding's a little while to night
