 P.M. G filled Pine stump holes awhile P.M.
 W. froze hard towards evening
 10 Chased put in new hay post A.M. G & boys
 took 1762 lbs hay to green river for Mr. Burton
 @ \$15.00 per ton W. froze very hard last night fine
 Monday 11 at home B. D. were here P.M. W. ^{that} ^{strong}
 12 lay in garden A.M. Plowed near B. C. P.M. ^{that} ^{strong}
 13 I went to Cedar Grove A.M. G threshed Peas B. D.
 Plowed P.M. froze last night. Sprouts Wagon
 works in Markham were burned last night
 14 began to plow about 9 A.M. finished near B. C.
 & began below garden W. fine clear sunny now
 P.M. B. D. & Joseph Wisner from Chilton were
 here awhile P.M. & B. A. N. & family this evening
 15 John & G finished plowing below garden I Chased
 & went to Cedar Grove P.M. W. mild
 16 I & John Plowed below orchard G helped at
 Hoch Barkholder's thresh. W. fine warm clear
 17 John & G nearly finished root ground below orchard
 I didn't feel well. Col. in head went to Cedar
 Grove P.M. W. fine & mild

Surveyors have ^{been} ^{operating} in this vicinity for
 about 2 weeks trying to locate a line for the
 Toronto & Ottawa railway. Surveyed from Toronto up
 through Scoboro through David Harris farm & B. D.'s
 west end, north of Cedar Grove by White Hill Mills to
 the north of Whitewal. found the crossing of Chuffin
 Creek rather expensive went back yesterday
 turned east below David Harris along fifth Con
 Scoboro a little south through W. Morrison
 farm (late Henry Peters) then found the elevation
 to high. turned back this morning crossed at the
 White Hill Mills east to south of Belford by
 Trut's farm & south of Whitewal. like the
 crossing better don't know if they will adopt it

 21 I & Nancy went to Markham A.M. G went
 home got some wood W. Clear rather mild
 22 G didn't come. no school. Governor's Thanksgiving
 day. John finished plowing root ground I went to
 Cedar Grove P.M. for meet. Pa. Hoover comes every
 Thursday. W. mild, rather drizzly
 23 I went to A. B. A.M. to ask them to help
 all our pigs on Tuesday. G cut edging A.M.
 threshed Peas P.M. W. drizzly & wet
 24 G threshed Peas A.M. cut wood P.M. we
 learned shop I & John went to D.M. for some
 we threshed Peas I went to D.D. to ask him to help
 all our pigs on Tuesday. W. ^{rain} ^{all} ^{day} ^{by} ^{H. Meyer}
