27. The forenoon was dull. Run raked the last field and Jimmie took it home. About noon it began to rain and rained heavily in afternoon. The boys went to Lancaster to play in a game with Huntington. The home team took 2. Run & Jimmie home at dusk. Jimmie had an experience today.

28. Rev. A. Jewell preached, text - 12 Psalm. Except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain. Mr. Green was at Apple Hill. J. B. is not well.

29. Pa drove Far to Lancaster, in as wild a rain storm as we had this summer. The storm began about 9 A.M. rained and drizzled all day.

30. The election of officers at Temple last night. I heard that Benjamin Slack died last night after a years illness suffering from cancer in throat which troubled him for about 3 years. Kind of showery today. 10 A.M. Run found W. Cow with calf in pasture this morning. Gave J. & R. each 25 for traps.

31. Slack was buried this afternoon. Pa got 2 lb tin of brown at Gustis 30. it is not good an old taste on it. Bidie getting herself a Mission ready for camping. This has been a wet month and a great deal of damage done by water throughout the world.
