Sun Oct 4th cloudy misting rain part of the day

Mon Oct 5th cloudy and rain in the fore noon, after noon flying clouds and high wind from the North. I was not doing much. Walter and Charles McIntosh was making cider

Tue Oct 6th a cold day fore part cloudy, we were husking corn in the fore noon after noon gathering and pitting apples.

Wed Oct 7th clear and pleasant a hard frost last night. we were husking corn in the fore noon after noon was pulling and pitting mangels

Thu Oct 8th cloudy and moderate we were husking in the fore noon drawing corn and pitting apples in after noon

Fri Oct 9th a wet day commenced to rain last night has been raining all day and is still raining now 8 P. M. we were sorting corn fore part of the day and grinding axes

October 1888

Sat Oct 10th cloudy rain part of the time, the boys was making cider for vinegar and hulling walnuts when it rained, I cutt down a silver maple tree that was standing by the house and cut up in fire wood.

Sun Oct 11th cloudy and some rain in the fore noon after noon clear and cool, was not at Church

Mon Oct 12th cloudy rain this Evening I was husking part of the day, Walter was gathering apples Rose moved to her new home this morning.

Tue Oct 13th clear fore noon cloudy after noon and high wind we were husking corn part of the day

Wed Oct 14th cloudy and cold we were husking corn Walter ~~Walter~~ was away this after noon to Lizzie Boyingtons wood bee

Thu Oct 15th cloudy and moderate, we were husking and drawing in corn.

Fri Oct 16th cloudy and wet in the fore noon, clear this Evening, walter finished making cider, I was sorting corn
