 here on Temperance missed the train
 and could not come so there was
 no meeting. There was a famine of
 bread today, until evening, 1 pan 25
 11 Bright and clear a little snow
 fell and kept the roads from
 being slippery. Took home 1 load of
 wood, in afternoon Far & Jimmie went
 to Farguhar Pan's widow's funeral
 she was buried here
