Fine day cool cloudy and sunny dry weather. We worked turnip land and got 20 dolls made and sowed Eandim Gem also sowed garden carrots 1 1/4 rows and some cabbage & some sunflowers planted some tomatoes. Willie down at night in buggy got millet at station that I sent to Waterloo for freight 35 ct. Sam W. Lee got load of manure & spread to day. We sowed the turnips one canister smallest holes all open other larger holes 2 closed cards same holes as latter. Willie took Mrs. Francis cow over to food at noon.

Thursday

Cloudy cool AM got warmer some sunshine then clouded over and rained at night. Mr. Gass over to day shined the sheep 20 of them paid him \$1.25. I put in anchor post North end of No 5. Willie disked in No 7 AM and in PM cultivated millet land in No 2. I sawed the millet by hand and went over it with the weeder afternoon. Mr. Dams paid us for hay got sometime ago \$8.00

Friday

Fine day mostly sunny warm. We worked drilled up and sowed 24 more drills turnips AM and in PM put up some of woven wire fence down No 5 stapled it to stakes temporarily. Emory Ford took home new 3 yr old registered dog name

Saturday

Fine sunny day warm. Willie worked rapel land etc No 7 to day. We got fence finished down No 5 the two rolls of woven wire nails to bottom. Willie down at night got at Nichols department also washed 10 sheep 10. Mr. Gass got butter 20
