June 9

Wednesday forward

Fine day cool cloudy and sunny dry weather.  
 We worked turnip land and got 2 bushels  
 made and sowed Canola. Also sowed  
 garden carrots 1/4 rows and some cabbage &  
 some sunflowers. Planted some tomatoes. Willie  
 down at night in buggy got milled at station  
 that I sent to Waterloo for freight - 35cts  
 Sam McRae got load of manure spreader today  
 We sowed the turnips one canister smallish holes all  
 open other larger holes 2 closed cans & a hole at latter.  
 Willie took Mrs Quairie cow over to rods at noon.

Thursday

Cloudy and AM got warmer some sunshine  
 then clouded over and rained at night. Mr  
 Gass over today sheared the sheep 20 of them  
 paid him \$1.25. I put in anchor post North  
 end of No 5. Willie disked in No 7 AM and  
 in PM cultivated millet land in No 2. I sowed  
 the millet by hand and went over it with weeder  
 afternoon. Mr Dame paid us for hay got sometime ago \$8.00

Friday

Fine day mostly sunny warm. We worked  
 disked up and sowed 24 more bushels turnips  
 AM and in PM put up some of woven  
 wire fence down No 5 stepped it to stakes  
 temporarily. Emory took home new 3gr ad registered typewriter

Saturday

Fine sunny day warm. Willie worked  
 up land in No 7 to day. We got fence finished down No 5  
 the two rolls of woven then rails to bottom. Willie down at night got  
 10 bushels of turnips and sowed 10. Mr Gass got butter 20
