We piled lumber in and bon yard and took down some of board fence to get driving shed (old kitchen) through then we moved the shed some more with Lucy hitched to rope and pulley. The girls and Willie drove down to school Entertainment tonight.

Exceedingly hard frost last night. Fine sunny day. We spread 3 loads manure from pig pen on No 2 (spreads) then worked at moving driving shed in P we got it moved up to garden fence opposite its final site.

Girls down town in P.M. got at Harmon's shoes for Bella \$3.75 at Stubs dry goods \$1.50

I went down town at eight paid C. Mattamini in full for kitchen and coal \$18.00 balance.
