October 22 continued Thursday forward
 Plow mended Hodge 10cts paid Andrew Gibson for 1/2 day work 25cts. I cleaned out pig pens etc. In P.M. C. Rea of Hudson came up and they and Willie got in 5 loads turnps nearly finishing them. we paid them in full C. Rea \$1.35 and 10cts for pairs with gloves J. D. \$1.35 also J. D. for H. S. \$1.55. Girls down town P.M. sold 2 1/2 doz eggs Armstrong 48 got groceries 57cts paid Miss Boulton Milling 40cts, stamps 10 envelopes 5 Pillsbury Willie went down at night to hear the Newstead the Conservative candidate speak. sent to Raymond to Gullpk 30cts for separate repair, 34¢ for also \$1.00 to G.M.C.A.

Friday

23 Misty morning fine sunny day. I plowed out rest of Mrs Duane's potatoes then did some of drain. Willie finished turnps in A.M. 2 loads and plowed No 7 P.M. 4 hours. Girls down town P.M. Lucy sold to Stals 6 lbs butter \$1.26 paid their a/c in full to date \$9.66 they got bins cold storage 25 meat mills 30, butter Cakes \$1.89. cook Armstrong on fr. 15. I made some of tanks for drain out of rails in P.M.

Cloudy warm raining some in A.M. and in evening again. We finished making tank and sunk it so far in drain Willie down town at night got lock for door stop for windows 25cts paid Bob Ken for mending strainer pail 10cts
