Mr. Amos Anderson Island Aug 21st

Put in 1 1/2 Loads of Pease Put in 7 Coals on the upper side put 5 on the east side put the Wheat on east side the cows Demolished the Corn coming in in the night 15<sup>th</sup> A fortunate Day finished cutting the Pease Put them in Put in 2 or 3 cribs of hay on east side Lashy came with his sackling Henry from Montreal to Day a full Dry time with warm Weather 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday Great smoke from the West 5 Pannels of our Fence on the Pitt Point burnt next the River High Wind Rain in the evening and at night Great Fires out some Place Hunting Commences in Lower Canada for Ducks 21<sup>st</sup> Monday Lashy Fishing Pickered got 17 Craped to the other side allowing some of the Oats its not Ripe But it is impossible to keep the Cattle out of it and it is all tramped cutting Hay some on the Lower Point Fencing some Tobacco the Green Leaf Packed it in a Match Box and Put 2 or 3 Layers of sugar on it and then pressed it with a heavy weight Christee here gave him a Ring for his scythe took dinner here Grinding his scythe impossible to catch the mare tonight Thunder to day 22<sup>nd</sup> cut the corn stalks Mowing some Peaking apples cut a coil of Marsh Hay at the River side very unwell though knocking around for all that Kingston went down to Day first Trip since she got smashed 23<sup>rd</sup> cutting some hay few Drops of Rain the Alma went up 24<sup>th</sup> cutting and gathering Hay Lashy craped took his Barrel here gathered a coil of Oats 25<sup>th</sup> A fortunate Day put in 15 Coals of hay on the east side got an apple from the Indian Lashy went to traps put a clout on the small Rain put in some corn stalks

Mr. Amos Anderson Island Aug 26<sup>th</sup>

Cut the last of the Oats cut a coil of Marsh Hay in the front Marsh High Wind 27<sup>th</sup> Sunday Lashy came took 2 Cats from traps here Lashy went to Salmon River Hazelnuts good Gordon & I on the Pitt Point after some 28<sup>th</sup> put in 2 small Loads of Oats Took in 1 Basket of sweet apples paid the Indians for the apple Lashy came some sober 28<sup>th</sup> cutting some hay on the Lower Point some Marsh hay in Back Marsh making the last of the Oats pulled the Beans Took up 2 Bushel of Apples Made a coil of Marsh hay on the Bank of the River South side next the Oats 30<sup>th</sup> Went to Mr. Harpers with Pat & Charles took about 13 Dandy eggs bought of Mr. Harper Flour 5/- Tea 5/- Soap 1/- sweets for Gordon Bought of a Summer 1/4 lb Starch Thread 1/2 needles 1/2 Meat 1/3 Lent my Knife to Long John to cut Tobacco and he did not return it to me Pat went to the fore heard of Mrs. Munroe being very low in the 2<sup>nd</sup> conception the Splinter Musk stopt in Hamiltons coming home heard a leander went off Charles & I came home 31<sup>st</sup> Went to Salmon River Charles & I took 3 lb of Wool 4 lb Bag of salt stopt at Lukes got a Taste to charge 6 cents or 3 of shunk plasters for the wool Mark 450 on the Bag gave Streeter 1 Sheel skin 2/6 to my acc B 4 meat of Beer at Normans paid Loan of a Battle from J. Baker Waiting at the Lines for a Pink a Steamer at Laports Island from Odgersburgh with hunters Mrs. Seno Derwishes Departed this life a Terrible time with small and 4 fires 1<sup>st</sup> of September Lashy went with the oak stick to Lancaster had to let it go after taking it as far as the light house thrashing and pulling some Beans Lashy making a Paddle
