- Wed Dec 5. Fine day a little milder. We got all cleaned up.
- Thur Dec 6. Snowing and then sleeting. Some sleighs out. We
put our hens in. Uncle took Aunties to N.A.
- Fri Dec 7. Fine but very cold. About 6 below zero. The girls
and I went to Aunt Lizzie's. Willie took us to
the Car in sleigh, Uncle came for us.
- Sat Dec 8. Down to 9 below zero. Then started to snow and
very rough all day. We went to Mother's, Willie
Cook out. fairly good sleighing.
- Sun Dec 9. Aunt Nellie and Uncle at Church. Milder and
foggy. Our cutter out. good sleighing - I went to
Fisherville. Mick came out. Uncle went for him.
- Mon Dec 10. Rained and sleeted, then cleared. Uncle went to
Toronto, to remain untill Wednesday. Mick here.
