Rain last night again sunny in A.M. clouded over in P.M. thunder lightning heavy rain at night. Ross Newman up allday Jim Ternal hoing to-day. We thinned turnips and got in hay and cut last night 5 loads Ab Campbell here in P.M. Father up in P.M. Paid Ross Newman on a/c \$1.00. Bob Sindell and I raked and coaled up most of Mrs Dumas hay after supper. Sold to Jackson cream \$1.10
