

JAMES CAMERON Island 16th of August 1900
Fine Day putting the Wheat in Stack Mr Hollister
and Augusta Plence here to Dinner Left 50 cts
I treated me to a Drop of Good Stuff Hot
Sun Fernandez crossed very Warm Working
some at my Boat Tomia and her Mother
went to Lisores finished the East Stack of Wheat
17th East Wind Began the other stack of Wheat
very Fine Day Fernandez came finished the stack
of Wheat 2 Stacks of Wheat Cutting the oats at my
Boat some 18th ~~Very~~ Fine Day put 2 Loads of
Hay in from the Lower Point coiling the oats
Working at my Boat Lady-Smith a Trip Down the
River Made 130 coils of Oats Tomia and Minnie
Fishing got 33 Rich Leander to Jo Douguets
with a Tub of Butter and 8 Doz of Eggs
Fernandez crossed for the Mail some Drops
of Rain 19th Bismarck's Birth Day 1870
Leander to church John H. here 2 Ladies and 2
Gentlemen here Mr Armstrong and Mr Barnhart
got 50 cents worth of Butter & Wind very Fine
Day 20th a very Fine Day & Wind Mr Barnhart
came with the Butter Plate Miss Jassie Smith
along with him They having a Pic Nic on the
south side of the Island Began a Stack of
oats put 9 Loads in it to Day not finished
to Day Fernandez Mowing Back of the Garden
21st & Wind a very Fine Day put 2 More Loads
in the Stack that's 10 Good Loads in this stack
Cut the oats above the Corn cut some
Marsh hay for topping of the stacks turned
my ~~Boat~~ shot a Hawk Fernandez to Summerstown
22nd Fine Made a Stack of oats 5 Loads in it Lissy & Minnie to
Summerstown 8 Doz of Eggs Mr Barnhart and Mr Armstrong here Bought
3 lb of Butter 2 Loaves of Bread and 1 Doz and 4 Eggs 90 cents Bought
Sugar 50 Fare 5 Seen Miss Murchison

James Cameron Island 23rd of August
a very Fine Day Cut the Pease cutting Marsh
Hay in the front Marsh Sacking Tin on My
Boat Fernandez went for the Mail gave the
Last of the old Potatoes to the Pigs Greased
the Waggon 24th St Bartholome Day Very
Warm Mowing and making coils in the
front Marsh Fernandez came this Morning
NEW MOON comes in this Evening
I have a Bad Pain in my Left Breast
Leander crossed 25th Very Fine Day very very
Warm cutting and Making coils in the
front Marsh over coils Made now George
and Mr Slocum here George and Fernandez
went Fishing got a Lot of Perch Mr Slocum
and I Trading in a variety of Curious Stones
and old Indian Curiositys pieces of Stone and
other odd things Gave Mr 2 Dollars for
them I Gave them to him more cheaper
as he is a Friend of Mrs Brodys very
very Sultry Thunder some this Evening
a Rain cloud Passed I think the Lucias
came to Fish as I heard their Dog Barking
on the Kit Kit Island my Breast very
Painful Lots of Boats going to Day Mosquitoes
Bad some odd shots at Ducks Before the
Time Corn Good 26th very Fine very very warm
I think yesterday Was awful hot Cornelius and Peter
and Barnhart's boy here Willie Rose here 2 Boys on
the Pitt Point got 2 lb of Butter Willie Rose came
from Dundee going to Lancaster 27th very Warm
& Rained a Few Drops Mr Barnhart for Butter and a
lot of Ladies and another Gentleman with them from
Montreal cutting the oats in the Back Place Set out
a Line Put my Boat in the Water Mr Genie came
had a Rat Trap 1 lb of Tea
