7 fine sunny day Willie cut another strip hay raked what was cut yesterday. We got in 4 loads to-day 3 to other barn 5 here. Bella down home in P.M. to quilting bee. Miss Burns Miss Gilson Mrs Bays Auntie and Jennie there.
