Wed Nov 29th cloudy and cool went over the river for the young cattle, and coring about the barn

Thu Nov 30th cloudy and snow most of the day was chopping wood part of the day. Anne and I was ~~was~~ setting up with Peter Farlerdeau last night he is very low

~~Dead~~

Dec 1 cloudy and soft, this fore noon helping to lay out Peter Farlerdeau ~~stayed~~ he died this morning, in the after noon kill'd a cow

Sat Dec 2 cloudy snow and blustering the latter part of the day, this fore noon cutting up the beef a kill'd yester day, after noon was filcing the hand saw and buck saw

Sun Dec 3rd clear and quite cool. I was paub. beaver for Peter Farlerdeau's funeral today

Mon Dec 4th cloudy and soft high wind from the South helping Albert Ketcheson butcher pigs

Tue Dec 5th cloudy and soft, I was chopping wood part of the day. Alice Catharine John and Anne went to Thamesville.

Wed Dec 6th cloudy and soft I was thrashing peas

Thu Dec 7th a cold blustering cold day, not doing much to ~~over~~ day

Camden Gore December 1882

Fri Dec 8th clear and cold, the boys and I were cleaning and putting up some grain to get chopt. the coldest day for this season, the river froze over ^{solid}

Sat Dec 9th cloudy and cold, Anne and I went to Thamesville I took a load of grain and got chopt

Sun Dec 10th cloudy and moderate

Mon Dec 11th cloudy snow most of the day was working about the barn part of the time Sent for the Dr to see Victoria she has the ~~dysentery~~ diphtheria

Tue Dec 12th cloudy after noon soft I was helping John W. Snarey butcher pigs. Anne Catherine and John went to Dresden

Wed Dec 13th cloudy rain last night, this fore noon soft snow wind from the South wind got round to North west and cold this after noon, I was thrashing peas part of the day

Thu Dec 14th cloudy and cold. I went to Arthur Anderson's and paid my taxes this fore noon after noon thrashing peas

Fri Dec 15th cloudy and cold, I was thrashing peas most of the day

Sat Dec 16th cloudy and cold, John went to Dresden with a load of oats and barley for Albert. I was thrashing ^{peas}
