My. off 10. 70 3 loaves 18. Far came at 2 P. M. his well wishers are giving W. M. Pherson Sen^r a banquet at the Glenco House tonight. Far came to it. Now 9.45 P. M. it is raining 28
- 2 A fine day after the rain of yesterday and last night. A large congregation Home Mission 1.00
- Murdie, John and Marion down. Farguhar left for Cornwall in afternoon took with him a cockrat. Jerry Asphinton
- 3 Nice bright day. Mrs J. Davidette paid 2.50 on rent 4 lbs butter from Factory

- 5 Not settled weather. Mrs A. M. Donald Kent \$5.00
- 6 I went to W. F. M. P. at Don. McCarrollons. It rained all afternoon My. off 50^{cts} tea 5 55
- 7 Cleared up. I made a small washing
- * 70 3 loaves 18. Paid Murdy for 3 got last week 36
- Sent a letter to D. B. one to Marion, one to Jennet M. Intosh. Got Factory report. 1.40
- 8 Fine bright day heavy gray frost last night. Jimie sent mine 1.00 and his offering for Temperance, 70 sugar 25^{cts} bread 18^{cts} 43
- Murdy went to McCallachs, back of Swamp
- 9 Rain, and looks like a day of rain
- 10. a. m. Sent off to Prayn Murray 25
- 10 Fine day. 4 lbs butter from Factory
- 11 Fine day. In afternoon Jennet M. Intosh came with 60 lbs honey. 12 cans 45 pr can 5.40
