

Mr Mills Cameron Island 2<sup>nd</sup> Sept 1882  
St Michael Michaelmas Day Fine  
Day Minnie crossed to Hamilton to get  
a Ride out to Mullamstown as they  
are going to the convent Picnic  
Hugh Ann and Emma put her a crop at  
the Potatoes put 17 Bushels in to Day  
31 Bushels in the cellar now cut the Meat  
and salted it Mr Long the Indian agent  
and Lewis Pike here getting the names  
of the Islands Sturgeon Island at the South  
East End of St Johns Island & L Island  
on the North side of St Johns Island about  
1/2 an acre of Land in each of them gave  
him the names of some other Islands the  
Get Kit Suppers or Butternut Snake or  
Ross's Island Squaw Island above the Hills  
Lighthouse Susse's Island above the  
Monument Island cat I Ball I  
Sheep I Dead Man I Seen a Big Fire  
this afternoon up the way of Summers town  
The Fishermen found Dan Frasers  
Boat as they were coming from Lancaster  
last night Bought of Mr Ward 2 1/2 lbs salt  
30<sup>th</sup> fine very windy put in 30 Bushels to  
Day Leander not well letting the water  
Run at the Wet Place 1<sup>st</sup> of October  
Sonia 13<sup>th</sup> Day 1883 Fine cool took  
13 Bushels from the East Potatoes  
put in marsh hay in stable loft

Mr Mills Cameron Island 2<sup>nd</sup> of Oct 1882  
Fine Windy Gordon and Dunks here  
Leander and Stanley to Lewis The Fire  
up the front was Billy on Leans Barn  
3<sup>rd</sup> at the Potatoes 70 Bushels in the  
cellar <sup>angus Mc Donalds Store burnt 13<sup>th</sup> Sept</sup> now commenced to Rain Thunder  
lightning <sup>Mc Quays Barn burnt</sup> cut 3 stalks of tobacco some  
of the sheep hurted 4<sup>th</sup> Fine Windy  
Rained Hail Leander and Hugh Ann  
to Dundee with Butter 75 to I Jyo and  
26 to Davidson 20 cents all Flour 6<sup>th</sup> 90  
took 200 Home and left 100 till we go again  
2 pairs of shoes 2<sup>nd</sup> 20 Milk Pans 1<sup>st</sup> 80 Pulbers 35  
R R R 2 Bolls 50 Fine Salt 60 2 Tubs 50 1 Tub 12  
velvet 10 Shirting 10 yards 90 Cinnamon 20 cash  
20 yds sateen Dollar got I Morris Coat another  
fire that Day of the Lightning a Man Barnil  
5<sup>th</sup> Harrowing Potatoes 75 Bushels in  
the cellar now very cold commenced a  
Harrow to make Stanley Did the first  
Ploughing with the colt to Day Dick  
went to Montreal North Wind Leander  
Began making a Harrow 6<sup>th</sup> Windy cool Fine  
Leander fishing with Narcisse went to  
the Head of the Island to look for a sheep  
thats not in the flock firing the saw  
and making leg for the Wood-saw-Horse  
Narcisse to Lancaster for Dick
