- 1 Went to Brockville with Granpa & Elan sold 34th butter for 11th half eggs & today got the number of several lots of land to look at very dry weather
- 2 plowed the turnip ground & washed the sheep the water was very cold
- 3 Sowed 2 rows of the Olleringham carrot as far as the ditch then I think some more of the Olleringham than the long one of 1848 the 1/2 row then of Sugar beet some of turnip seed then we went to Granpa & Mrs Young to Sabla's Widening she is married to Thomas Smith
- 4 Trimed some of the Apple trees in the forenoon Isable & her husband came here in the afternoon
- 5 went to Lansdown to Ben Young's with Elan his wife is very sick then Jack & me went to look at some land in the 5th & 5th concession pine low land but there is a chance of it being plowed by the Merchant
- 6 dragged & ridged up the turnip ground then sowed them Jack & Granpa sheared part of the Sheep
- 7 very heavy rain last night went to cantown & heard the Rev Mr McMurtry preach
- 8 moved the fence down to the woods in the field below the little orchard Jack & Granpa finished shearing the sheep fine day
- 9 made 4 bolsters & 4 stakes for the waggons Jack went to Sharkeyness for lime but it was gone for nothing the fence the brush fence around the
- 10 made 2 packs for the horses Jack went to William Mackey & got 350 feet of hamsack bands
- 11 heavy rain all day shaded the horses
- 12 planted between 3 & 400 cabbage with a piping
- 13 cleared away the stones between the houses
- 14 The Rev went to Brockville & heard the Rev Mr Morrison preach
