 2nd Sunday 3 Wind changed to West W Randolph and
 I to hit at Kops and Buller nut or Charles Selors
 Caspers cano hanging on Charles Island
 they treated me went to Squaw Island
 wind changed to South West 43 low high
 23rd Livinia Birth Day 1868 Evening Floor in sheep
 place 24th Our 10th Birth Day 1877 cleaning
 Big shed 25th My Birth Day St Crispin
 Shoemakers Day cleaning Big sheds
 got a meat of Wine on my 26th Day 26
 Banking the West end of the house
 got a Surgeon from Philip

 finished the Big shed took along stone outlay it and
 smashed the door of Mr Wilson of Fort Covington
 lawyer 13th Profession came down for a hunt
 at Truck his son and Billy Morris Treater
 we had 4 or 5 Hounds and went off in the
 Morning left the Wife a Dollar in silver
 gave me a Chimney of Sodaco Bankers the House
 28th Randolph and Philip crossed to Summers but
 brought the little Boat Back again took another
 pair and took a pair for his Mother 14th
 on credit Bought 1 lb Sea 50 paid 2 lb
 of nail paid putting gut manure around
 the apple trees 29th Sunday Went to hit
 at Kops and Buller nut or Charles Selors
 3 amere and Squaw Island wind changed
 to South West and blew hard 30th
 Made cheese Evening Milk house shed
 Bottled 2 Gallons of Wine cut some hair
 31st Koly we cracking nuts eating
 Apples Reading Burrys Hollow
 Banking 1st of Nov the cook house and
 Milk house shed Randolph to the Kit Hill
 for Boards 1st of November The
 Harvest month of Death all saint
 Day Fishermen went off High wind
 left their seine lines too hard they
 think they will come Back again
 getting the Boys hair or heads Bad
 with cold I no all Stools Day Barbours
 head no day Bad cold 7th next best melt
 moved some grains Steamer Maid
 stop at lower point put more
 hay on the sheds pushing the wood at
 the door installed 2 young Hoovers
 filled my Stew 7th
