Dec. 17, Lovely today but a little cool, spent the day at job lanes and Mr Vertwey attended practice to night Mr. P. Hesterson returning from Kingston with Chas. Fankorn was thrown from the waggon and instantly killed. Miss Georga Watts here to night

Sun, 18, Dull and squally day, considerable snow fell during the day Miss Watts and myself were invited to Mr W Adoo's this evening but it being stormy we did not go

Mon, 19, Snowing this morning, fall of snow about four inches, clearing off partly, cold and clear to night Miss Barton Miss W Adoo & Mr W Adoo, here at Mrs Corons to night visiting

Dec 20th 1892

Tue, 20, Most beautiful, but very cold, most like winter than any time yet this season

Wed 21, Lovely day a little squally in the forenoon, decorated the Wesley Church today, with the assistance of the young folks of the above Church

Thu 22, Fine but cold, attended the School examination today Miss Etta Watts Teacher. I ~~was~~ enjoyed myself very much ~~engaged with job lanes as~~ ~~pressed water for the ensuing year~~ after tea I went down to Mr Hardings, and and went with them out to the port road school house to a concert held there stoped at Mrs Gavisos before going and after arrived home about twelve o'clock
