Therefore guarded the cows in the field by the house. rained in the afternoon Well was up to Port in Mill it was raining when he got home. Hattie was up to business meeting yesterday to Cook's Mills last night on the night the wind blew a gale poured rain & haled the poor turkeys had a hard night. Wed 17. the children took the coat down when they went to school & put them on the field but it was so cold & rainy they brought them up & put them on the barn. I churned Marguerite made Marguerite's brown waist over, we got Paul apples over in the cellar it was too cold ground froze & a little snow on the ground.

Thur 18. Well went to Chippawa with the chickens & bought his socks & rubber after dinner Arthur helped me with the stove & Marjorie blacked the stove the Lucy dog went down with Arthur when he went to plough & he got so cold Well went after him

Friday 19. quite a bit of snow on the ground soft & melting like rain at times lots of water running away on the west side of the house Arthur did not plough today I cleaned up the pantry Marjorie & Gordon have guests Leslie & Maryngate now Mrs R went up to Buffalo on Sunday & at 2 o'clock Marjorie & Gordon guarded the cows Marguerite new曹 apples & made an apple sauce cake grape tart & a pint back kitchen & swept under kitchen Gordon cut a lot of wood - Marjorie swept the front room but did not get round

Jan 21 all from the other house & the children went to church Marjorie could not wear her top the minister to Well to dinner we expected Remmiger girls & Florence but they did not come Arthur & Arthur over in the evening

From 2-2 raining pretty nearly all day I worked at times got soaking weturing the cows & getting the turkeys on the back farm for they had a hard night of it pouring on them most of the night the young ones got wet coming home at noon Marguerite & them had a time at night doing the chores. Marguerite made her red pants Paul came home at night from Frank Taft

Jan 23 turned cold in the night & the wind strong north W. Marjorie helped Paul cook Topsy & went out in the river to get his clothes. He got the tall barrel out of the wagon it was there over a week Arthur went to Chippawa after dinner in a cold time harness mended. I cut out my flannel shirt

Marguerite & the girls & Frank left other house. cold night - Wed 24 Well took his team down to the butcher. Mrs Remmiger sick Marguerite & Paul went over, I put the back on Paul's coat going in the bitter cold bought I got a lot of ramblers in

After 25. wind east chill one through I have a terrible headache Remmiger went to mill & threshed wheat works Marguerite over in bed if we wanted to send with them. They could only get one hundred & let us have half. We came at night to tell us Paul working for Walmsley getting on straw. Practice at Harrow in night Arthur went to Chippawa had 5¹⁰ 2¹⁰ 15¹⁰ sugar 25 lea 30 wheat 25 cornmeal 10 Turnips 25. Hogs coal oil 14. onions 10 stamp 4. I sent a dollar for the Sp 2¹⁰

Arthur soon getting Don Wells drill mended I charmed 2¹⁰ 9¹⁰ after one week the teacher to Harris River Friday 26 Mary Remmiger over after I ate butter 23¹⁰ for the Rob walk down to Chippawa. Arthur ploughing on their compound Paul charmed stone all the morning at 11 then Marguerite blacked the pots I washed out some
