Fine sunny day warm very dry weather. We finished cutting No 7 7 L to-day got it mostly stooked. I stooked most of barley No 2 after-noon. Girls down town P.M. got at Armstrongs on of sugar bananas and custic soap. Mr Gass milk 5⁻ Girls at Quarris for tea.

Fine sunny warm day. I finished stooking No 7 7 L. also barley No 2 A.M. Father up in morning to see about provincial stock Willie drove him down then went to Bob Kunk with Jess. In P.M. Willie and Teddy Lator pulled saw thistle out of pease oats etc. Paid kin 25⁻ They took 2 calves Quarris heifer and Jersey steer (cow sucker) down to home pasture at night. Dena flock of black birds around.
