Sampson for buggy \$63.75 balance got meat at cold storage \$11.50 sold eggs 42, at Phillips Lohm of potassium for lump jaw 75 lbs Girls down in P.M. got at Russell goods \$1.04 dry goods drage \$3.45 stamps 6 I topped turnips in A.M. Willie came over with an spreader harrowed them out and we took load over. In P.M. W & C. Rea came up. We pulled and trimmed and they hauled loads. We got 3 loads harrowed over to roothouse and 4 trimmed loads to pit on spreader loads.
