23 the Revd Mr Cochran preached in the schoolhouse

24 finished cutting the center field & cut some  
in the field below the house fine day

25 finished cutting the field below the house to  
center ditch & cut a little on the east side

26 raked some of the field below the house  
& mowed the most of the east side

27 finished the mowing all but that for seed  
& got it all in cock a little rain <sup>is not a very</sup>

rain 28 stacked the hay Cristie young & some <sup>of the</sup> boys  
rain & Wm Connet helped I could do nothing my <sup>side</sup> hurt

29 I went to Exeat & got 5000 of lath from I & George  
for the church gave his son \$10 he sends me 500

30 the Revd Mr Cochran preached in the forenoon  
& the Revd Mr Francis in the afternoon I then  
went to Younger her mother is very bad

31 went to the funeral of G. Sonnie there was 35 persons  
got a telegram that Bromanome is dead I went to Malton place  
in the Express & walked over to Robert's
