Mon Apr 11th cloudy and soft. commenced to rain about 3 P M I commenced to dig the garden

Tue Apr 12th a cold cloudy day spitting snow most of the day. I tried to dig in garden the cold drove me out. Bilton

Wed Apr 13th light clouds wind from the North and cold. a hard frost last night. the ground froze to hard to dig the garden this morning. Maud called in this after noon.

Thu Apr 14th cloudy cold furies of snow most of the day and cold. the pump was froze up this morning. Bilton called this fore noon I helped Willie McDintosh set a few fruit trees this after noon

Fri Apr 15th a stormy day. Snow all day and drifting this evening. Sarah was here cleaning house & baking.

Sat Apr 16th clear most of the day. Snow away pretty fast. about six inches fell yesterday and last night

Sun Apr 17th clear and pleasant over head plenty of mud under foot. hard frost last night

Mon Apr 18th cloudy and moderate. I was digging in the garden awhile this after noon Bilton was here this after noon
