Thu Aug 21<sup>st</sup> cloudy and hot fore part of the day a heavy thunder shower this after noon. Mary Paul called this fore noon. Pearl called this evening she says Sarah is some better

Wed Aug 22<sup>nd</sup> clear and hot 90 deg. Charley came over and brought me a loaf of bread and a pie. no word from the Californian

Thu Aug 23<sup>rd</sup> clear and hot in the fore noon. after noon thunder showers pearl and Will Mcintosh was in

Fri Aug 24<sup>th</sup> fore noon cloudy after clear Billon was here most of the fore noon

Sat Aug 25<sup>th</sup> cloudy most of the fore noon after noon clear and hot. Sarah was here this evening the Californian folks arrived Catharine and her oldest and youngest boys came with them

Sun Aug 26<sup>th</sup> clear and hot part of the day there a thunder shower this evening

Mon Aug 27<sup>th</sup> cloudy and little in the fore noon after noon clear and cool. I went to the black Smith Shop and on over to Henry Johnstons barn where William was thrashing. Sarah was over here she has got back home again

Tue Aug 28<sup>th</sup> light clouds and cool. Mrs Chaple called in a few minutes. I cut the weeds about the yard

Wed Aug 29<sup>th</sup> clear and cool. I hoed up a few weeds in the garden. Sarah was over

Thu Aug 30<sup>th</sup> clear and cool. one of Henry Mary girls came and brought my Methodist Magazine they took out of the Post Office the young Minister called and had pray
