Very frosty day again sunny most of day. I dug up two places in drain and showed a No 9 wire with stick on end through tile to see if drain was blocked then laid 3 more till got drain beyond quick sand. We gathered in implements and brought up load wood from bush. We put 2 heifers in stable leaving 14 cattle that we feed in other barn loose, with hay only. Paid Allan 1.00 saw aft.

Considerable more snow through night snowing and drizzling rain all A.M. and some P.M. I took the load wood we brought up last night down home then brought up load manure from stals spread in on Nos 8. Then we took waggons to other barn and brought over slings. In P.M. we put more implements under cover. I went down town at night in buggy got dung forks at Nichols boots Willie drove Bella down in P.M. she settled stals aft<sup>10.27</sup> and paid 50 cts for wisets Rec print for wool took down in July 11th 13.39
