Mary walked down P.M. got teeth attended to at Arthur's got at Russell's goods 41cts meat shortcuds 75cts.

### Wednesday

Fine morning very warm clouded over rained heavy all P.M. and evening. N.S. up all day thinning mangels A.M. pulling mustard till rain P.M. then cleaned stables roothouse etc. I drilled up for rape in E corner of No 3 Willie harrowed drains etc then he went down town got rape at Ellis & his \$1.00 brought up 7. M & Aunt Aggie went to Elora rocks came back in 4 P.M. train. Willie drove 7 down about that time. The drains came back to-day got started at main bottom of No 5 running parallel with G.A. fence We sold unwashed fleece 14lbs @ 28cts \$3.92 also sack wool \$1.50 to Jew. Willie and Nelson took white aysline hifon to Trinidad about 6 P.M. Willie also got at Ellis gelatine 15cts bread etc 7cts 34cts
