	Frost last night and snow ground while with it sunny and cloudy through day snowing at times. We thrashed all day following hands for Mikee Jack Crabbe Dave Skewch Jim Ford Fraser Fisher. Gus Black Frank Priestly Sam Mikee R Rogerson R Trindle Mr Pick. Mother and amite up all day.

27	Exceedingly hard frost last night. Sunny and cloudy day very cold ice and snow not melted. Willie drove down in morning got at Hamiltons on up 100 lbs candle wad for thrashing and loaf bread at roots 6. We finished thrashing by noon to-day. Willie went to Pikes thrashing in P.M. Ross Newman and Jim Howard up in P.M. we got in 3 loads turnips. Paid Jim Clark 25 cts going behind carriers			6
28		Friday		25
	Not so cold to-day sunny and cloudy. Willie at Pikes thrashing and all and allans in P.M. Ross and Jim up all day. We got in six loads turnips Bays up at Ludeles 2 or 3 hours in P.M. helping Bob with his turnips. Scott sick in morning Willie sent up food Armstrong he gave him drunch etc.
