

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 15, 1870.

I stayed all night last night at Mr. Wilsons and slept with Frank. I stayed on account of wind. Came home again this morning and found the road very muddy. Went out again after dinner, all hands of us to see the ~~show~~ Township show. I called to see some sheep on the road at Mr. Wilsons place, which I have thought to add to my flock. Had quite a pleasant time at the show but didn't rather like and had a disagreeable job doing chores.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 16, 1870.

We have not been away from home so long it being the day for our other service. The weather is delightful, more like June than October.

Our dear minister was present with us so day and gave us an excellent discourse from the Jews light on the Calves and Abrahams. drive them away. He likened the Jews to sinful thoughts which are always in finding upon our endeavours to worship God. Our only remedy is to do as Abraham did - drive them away. I have been much grieved by the sermon today.
